What Can I Do?

- Visit www.rawindfarm.com and:
 - Use the links to sign the 10 Downing Street petitions for (a) a 2km separation between wind turbines and houses and (b) a review of the discredited wind farm noise assessment standard ETSU-R-97.
 - Use Contact Us to let us have your email address so that we can keep in touch with you.
- Look out for a public meeting with Peel which is being arranged by Frodsham Town Council. We expect this to be announced by notices in places such as the Town Council notice board on the Lloyds TSB building and Main Street Post Office.
- Look out for a Planning Application from Peel in late February. We expect this to be announced in the Chester Chronicle.
- Look out for walks on the marshes - for people who value the marshes and people who want to learn more about them. We expect these to be arranged end March/early April. Details will probably be provided on posters and in Frodsham Post and Helsby News.
- When we clearly and unequivocally know what Peel are proposing (so far as you can in these situations), then write to the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change with a copy to Cheshire West and Chester Council. We will provide addresses.
- Read John Etherington "The Wind Farm Scam". It is well-written, it provides lots of background information on the issues and it is fairly easy to read.
